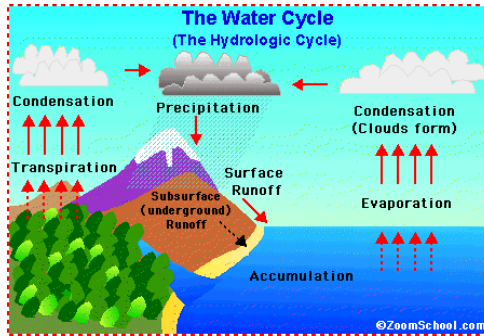




CLASS 5/6 HALF TERM NEWSLETTER
