Dear Year 6 Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the new school year. We are looking forward to a great time together. Please find below some useful information about Year 6.

The teacher in Year 6 is Mrs Rudall.

The main adult who supports teaching and learning in Year 6 is Mrs Cox.

## Home-learning:

- Google Classroom: I have set up a Top Class Role Models google classroom page; I will upload homework tasks and update pupils on any relevant information. This is also a platform for pupils to ask any questions outside of school hours to avoid them worrying at home.
- Maths active- learn tasks will be assigned on a weekly basis. (Your child will be coming home with a password card for them to access all the relevant academic sites)
- Spelling homework will be sent home weekly. Spellings will be in a separate folder and children may choose a number of different ways to practise these. Spelling tests will be completed every Friday; folders must be brought into school daily. There will be activities within the folder for your child to complete. Children date the spelling to the week they complete the test. They will update their mark at the bottom of the column.
- Reading: it is useful to read at least 10 minutes every night. Reading books will come daily but reading records will be kept in school.

Please note that in year 6, to prepare the children for life at comprehensive school, it is important that they have ownership of completing homework tasks and remembering to bring the correct items to school. Please continue to support your child in this essential area.

Remember if at any point, your child has any concerns over homework or other issues please do not hesitate to contact me.



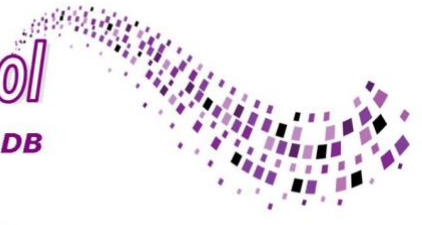

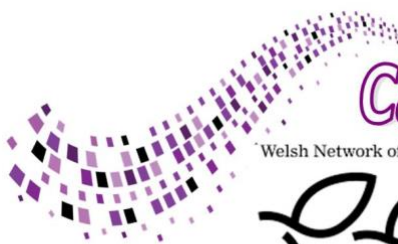
